CIRCULAR

Sub: Accounting of Public Contributions to the Calamity Relief Fund and issue of receipts – regarding.

In the Govt. Order No.FD 23 TAR 2009 dated:29-09-2009 sanction has been accorded to open the head of account “8235-00-111-0-02-Public Contribution to the Calamity Relief” for receiving contributions to “Calamity Relief Fund of Karnataka”. The Deputy Commissioners of Districts have been authorized therein to receive contributions from public/agencies/Institutions and to credit the same to the above head of account in the Treasuries. Bangalore One Centres have also be authorized to collect Cheques or Demand Drafts in respect of contributions made to the “Calamity Relief Fund of Karnataka” in Govt. Order No.FD 23 TAR 2009 dated:6-10-2009.

A clarification has been issued in Govt. Order No.FD 23 TAR 2009 dated:7-10-2009 regarding administration of Calamity Relief Fund declaring Public contributions to Calamity Relief Fund as a part of Chief Minister’s Relief Fund and instructions have been given therein to mention this point in the receipts/acknowledgements. However it is noticed that this aspect is not being mentioned in the receipts/acknowledgements issued by Chief Minister’s Office, Bangalore One Centres etc. Inview of this, following procedure may be followed for issuing receipts/acknowledgements for contributions/donations received for Calamity Relief.

1. The receipts/acknowledgements issued in respect of contributions received from Public/Agencies/Institutions towards “Calamity Relief” may be given in the following format:
“Received Rs. from Sri/Smt.
towards Donation to Chief Minister’s Relief Fund as public contribution to Calamity Relief. The Donation is eligible for exemption under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act.

2. For the contributions already received, a revised receipt/acknowledgement in the above format may be issued, if asked by the Donor.
